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

# THE "CAISSE DE DÉPÔT ET DE CONSIGNATION DE CÔTE D'IVOIRE (CDC-CI)" IS LAUNCHING AN

#### INVESTMENT FUND:

On Monday, June 19, 2023, the GIC-CI, represented by its President Mr. LUCMAN DIABY, participated in the official launch of the Caisse de Dépôt et de Consignation de Côte d'Ivoire (CDC-CI)'s Long-Term Investment Facility (FILT) called CDC-CI Capital.

This fund, totaling 38 billion FCFA, is equipped with two compartments. The first compartment, with a size of 8 billion FCFA, is dedicated to financing projects led by youth and women. The second compartment, with a size of 30 billion FCFA, is dedicated to large enterprises focused on priority sectors such as green agriculture and agroindustry.

To benefit from this fund, companies must operate in Côte d'Ivoire or in the UEMOA zone, with the condition that 20% of the shareholding be held by an Ivorian or that 30% of the turnover be generated in Côte d'Ivoire.

Investments are made through minority equity stakes and seed capital for companies, following a model of 5 years of investment and 5 years of divestment, which can be extended for an additional 2 years.

# THE PRICE OF CASHEW NUTS: NKALO.COM EXPERTS STILL RECOMMEND SELLING

The cashew nut market in Côte d'Ivoire has been challenging and generally quiet throughout the month of June. Despite sporadic exchanges between local speculator buyers and processors seeking to consolidate their stocks, demand remains scarce in the production areas.

The persistent difficulty in the cashew market in Côte d'Ivoire, combined with the deterioration in nut quality, has led to a lack of liquidity and a decrease in demand.

Government-led collective sales operations have not had much impact due to low stock levels involved. The quality of the nuts has degraded, resulting in many exporters ceasing their purchases.

On-farm prices have fluctuated between 100 and 250 FCFA/kg, while port prices range between 200 and 270 FCFA/kg. Producers have struggled to find buyers and have been encouraged to sell their stocks, even at low prices, to avoid an accumulation of products during the upcoming season.

# CAMBODIA: CASHEW ASSOCIATION MEMBERS NEGOTIATE LOWER INTEREST RATES

Members of the Cambodian Cashew Association (CAC) will soon benefit from a preferential interest rate of 5.5% through an agreement with the Small and Medium Enterprise Bank of Cambodia (SME Bank). This reduction from the previous rate of 9 to 12% aims to improve access to financing for small and medium cashew processing enterprises. The president of CAC emphasizes that the lack of capital has long hindered the industry's growth, leading to a shortage of local cashew nuts and the constant need to recruit and train new employees. An allocated amount of \$100 million from SME Bank is expected to help alleviate these difficulties. The collaboration between SME Bank and CAC is seen as a strategic way to stimulate the growth of Cambodia's cashew sector. The reduced interest rate could incentivize cashew processors to increase their production. However, cashew exports from Cambodia to Vietnam have decreased by 12.95% compared to the previous year.

# GHANA: THE COMMODITY EXCHANGE TO LIST THE CASHEW NUTS

The Ghana Commodity Exchange (GCX) is planning to list raw cashew nuts on its trading platform to develop the cashew value chain in Ghana. GCX currently trades in grains, but would like to add cashews as well. A meeting between GCX and the World Food Program brought together key players to develop a viable model for the cashew sector. The CEO of GCX highlights the benefits of a structured platform for actors in the cashew value chain. GCX is looking to increase storage capacity and is working with the Department of Agriculture to utilize available warehouses. Cashew sector challenges inconsistent quality, fluctuating prices and limited access to finance. GCX offers a structured market model, standardized quality and access to funding to meet these challenges. Actors such as the World Food Program and the Timber Crops Development Authority support this initiative. The global cashew nut market is growing, estimated at \$10 billion and expected to reach \$12.7 billion by 2024.

### CÔTE D'IVOIRE SECURES \$450 MILLION INVESTMENT FOR THREE PROJECTS ON THE SIDELINES OF THE AFRICA CEO SUMMIT 2023

The Ivorian government has signed three memorandums of understanding worth US\$450 million to stimulate economic growth and create jobs.

The first agreement concerns the construction of a cashew nut processing plant with a capacity of 200,000 tons per year. The total investment amounts to 100 million US dollars.

The second agreement aims to develop a plantain banana plantation on 900 hectares, that will create jobs for 190 young farmers.

The third agreement provides for the construction of a complex of three towers on the site of the Ivorian Press Agency.

In addition, the Ivorian Minister of Construction has signed an agreement with the International Finance Corporation for a housing project in public-private partnership.

These initiatives aim to foster sustainable economic growth and private sector development in Côte d'Ivoire.

# TANZANIA LAYS OUT STRATEGIES TO MEET CASHEW PRODUCTION TARGET OF 400,000 TONNES FOR 2023/24 SEASON

The Tanzanian government, through the Ministry of Agriculture, has put in place strategies to achieve production of 400,000 tonnes of cashew nuts in the 2023/24 season. This includes early distribution of agricultural inputs and training farmers in best cultivation practices. The last season's production was lower than previous years, making it necessary to improve yields. The Cashewnut Board of Tanzania will be responsible for the supply of powdered sulfur and pesticides. Players in the sector emphasize the importance of farmers' contribution to complement government's efforts. Tanzania aims to increase cashew production per tree. Globally, Africa contributes 56% of global cashew production, largely dominated by India and Vietnam.



# VIỆT NAM AND IVORY COAST TO PROMOTE AGRICULTURE AND TRADE COOPERATION

Vietnam and Cote d'Ivoire have agreed to strengthen their cooperation in the field of agriculture and facilitate trade in cashew nuts, cotton and cocoa, among other products. Both countries recognize the importance of mutually beneficial economic and trade cooperation. Vietnam is positioning itself as a model of success and inspiration in the fight against poverty. Both parties are ready to facilitate access to the respective markets for key products. Vietnam is committed to serving as a gateway for products in Asia. Agricultural cooperation, especially in the cashew value chain, is a priority. The two countries are also considering vocational training and exchanges in other fields. The two National Assemblies will play a catalytic role in promoting bilateral cooperation. A memorandum of understanding for cooperation between the two Assemblies was signed at the end of the discussions.

# THE GLOBAL CASHEW LIQUID MARKET CNSL

#### Market overview:

The value of the markets where Cashew Shell Liquid (CNSL) could be applied reached a value of US\$346 billion in 2022 and is projected to reach US\$691.66 billion in 2032, growing at an average annual growth rate of 8%. Growing demand for CNSL as an eco-friendly and renewable raw material for various applications is one of the major market growth factors. CNSL, a by-product of cashew processing, is natural, sustainable, and used in the automotive, agricultural, pharmaceutical, and other industries. It is used in the manufacture of products such as surfactants, coatings, adhesives and friction materials. CNSL is also used as an energy source due to its high calorific value.



#### **Demand Growth Factors:**

The growth of the CNSL market is supported by the growing demand for eco-friendly and sustainable products. A renewable and environmentally friendly raw material, CNSL can be used in various applications as a replacement for petroleum-based products. Being non-toxic and biodegradable, CNSL does not pollute the environment. Thus, the growing demand for sustainable and eco-friendly products is driving the growth of the market.

Another driving force behind the market is the growing demand for CNSL in the automotive sector. Due to its exceptional thermal stability and frictional qualities, CNSL is used in the manufacture of brake linings and clutch pads. Rising demand for lightweight and fuel-efficient vehicles is also driving the growth of the CNSL-based friction materials market.

Moreover, the growing demand for CNSL in the pharmaceutical industry is a major factor driving the growth of the market. CNSL exhibits therapeutic qualities such as anti-inflammatory, analgesic, and antibacterial effects, making it a basic ingredient in the manufacture of drugs to treat various diseases such as diabetes, cancer, and arthritis.

The growth of the CNSL market is also supported by investments in research and development to create new applications. However, factors such as fluctuating raw material costs, accessibility of raw material substitutes, and lack of knowledge about CNSL and its uses in different sectors may restrain the growth of the market. Additionally, the scarcity of cashew shells may also limit the market growth to some extent.



#### **Opportunities:**

Due to the large production and consumption of cashew nuts, Asia-Pacific dominates the CNSL market. Countries like India, Vietnam and Indonesia are major producers. The demand for CNSL has increased in the construction, food and beverage industries, as well as in the pharmaceutical industry. The use of CNSL in the production of coatings, adhesives and resins has significant growth potential. Government programs to promote bio-based products will drive demand for CNSL in Asia-Pacific.

North America is also an important market for the CNSL thanks to its research and development capabilities and its technological advances. The industrial, automotive, healthcare and construction sectors are the primary users of CNSL, with strong growth potential. The region is expected to adopt more green chemistry techniques, thereby increasing the demand for CNSL.

In Europe, the demand for CNSL is expected to increase due to the increasing use of bio-based products and stringent environmental regulations. The construction industry uses CNSL products extensively, and the food and beverage industry also use CNSL due to its antioxidant and flavoring properties.



#### **Competition:**

The global Cashew Nut Shell Liquid (CNSL) market is highly competitive, with a number of large and medium-sized players accounting for the majority of market revenue. The major players are deploying various strategies, including mergers and acquisitions, strategic agreements and contracts, development, testing, and introduction of more efficient products.
