# **Instructions to use Wonder.me**

In order to access the room, follow the next steps:

- 1. Open the link from Google Chrome or Microsoft Edge.
- 2. Give Wonder permission to access your camera and microphone by clicking on "Request browser permissions" and accept Wonder's request in your browser.
- Introduce the guest password: network\_meeting\_21
- 4. Select the sources you prefer using in your device to capture voice and video and click "Next".
- 5. Click on "Take photo" and write your name to create your avatar (you can change them later). Then click "Next" to get into the room.
- 6. Once you are in the room, you can use your mouse to move your avatar around. Click and hold to move in the direction of the dot that is stuck to your avatar.
- 7. Every time you come in close contact with someone else's avatar, a circle will pop up around the two of you, and you will have a videochat. Anyone who comes into that circle will also become involved in that videochat. You can leave that circle and join other circles with other people at any time. There can be up to 15 people in each circle at a time.
- 8. You can use the buttons in the right-hand side of the screen to see the list of participants, send text messages, change your avatar/name, modify your audio/video sources, etc.

### Instructions to self-selecting in a breakout room

1. Click Breakout Rooms in your meeting controls.

- 2. Hover your pointer over the number to the right of breakout room you wish to join, click Join, then confirm by clicking Join.
- 3. Repeat as necessary to join other breakout rooms or click Leave Room to return to the main session.
