Eligibility

Teacher

Eligible participants includes;

- Individuals who hold a dance teacher or instructor qualification issued by recognized/certified associations or organizations
- Or, individuals who works at a dance school operated by someone who holds qualifications.

Student

Eligible participants includes;

• Individuals who do not hold any of the above qualifications and are currently studying under a qualified teacher.

- *Participation in a wheelchair is not permitted
- *For Championship, Multi-dance, Scholarship, and Doubles sections, students allowed to participate even if they are not registered as a couple.

Competition Rules

- There are no costume rule/restrictions for all sections.
- Music length is as follows;

Preliminaries: 1 minute 10 seconds

Finals: 1 minutes 15 seconds

Finals will be held with live music performed by a band.

Doubles Competition Rules

Basic Rules

- Each pairs must consists of 2 dancers.
- Both dancers must be of the same gender.

Competition Style

- Any step/choreography of Latin American dance, including basic figures, is allowed.
- More than half of the routine must be single steps without contact (e.g., holding hands or placing a hand on a shoulder).
- If clear leading actions such as rotating the partner are used, the same step must be performed with roles reversed.
- The following actions are generally prohibited:
 - 1. Lying on the floor
 - 2. Kneeling on the floor for more than 3 seconds
 - 3. Lifting a partner
 - 4. Dancing with hands on the floor
 - 5. High rondes that may endanger other competitors (Partially based on JDC Latin Doubles Competition Rules)

Junior Competition Rules

Eligibility

- Juvenile: Under 12 years old on the day of the event
- Junior: Under 15 years old on the day of the event
 - *Duplication of participation in Juvenile and Junior sections is not permitted.
 - *When partners are in different ages, the higher age will be applied.

Other Rules

No dress code or figure restrictions apply.

Judging

- Ranking will be calculated based on the total points from two rounds: preliminaries and finals.
- The number of judges varies by section.

Awards

• Trophies will be awarded to the 1st place in each section. Certificates will be awarded to 1st to 6th place.

• Eligibility: Open to all students

• Events: WTF CSR 3 dances combined

• Entry Limit: 1 student per teacher (up to 24 couples*)

Rounds: Preliminaries & Final

Entry Fee: 30,000 yen

Duplication of participation in Latin and Ballroom is not permitted.

Section "S&T Single dance"

• Eligibility: Open to all students (students can participate with each other)

Events: WTVwFQ CSRPJ

• Entry Limit: Up to 5 students per teacher per event

Rounds: Preliminaries & FinalEntry Fee: 10,000 yen / 1 event

AGE

Section "Age-group Ruby"

• Eligibility: Combined age under 90 (combined age of teacher and student)

• Events: WTF CSR

• Entry Limit: 1 student per teacher per event

Rounds: Preliminaries & FinalEntry Fee: 8,000 yen / 1 event

Section "Age-group Sapphire"

• Eligibility: Combined age 90 or over (combined age of teacher and student)

• Events: WTF CSR

• Entry Limit: 1 student per teacher per event

Rounds: Preliminaries & FinalEntry Fee: 8,000 yen / 1 event

Section "Age-group Diamond"

• Eligibility: Combined age 110 or over (combined age of teacher and student)

• Events: WTF CSR

• Entry Limit: 1 student per teacher per event

Rounds: Preliminaries & FinalEntry Fee: 8,000 yen / 1 event

Section "Age-group Platinum"

• Eligibility: Combined age 120 or over (combined age of teacher and student)

• Events: WTF CSR

• Entry Limit: 1 student per teacher per event

Rounds: Preliminaries & FinalEntry Fee: 8,000 yen / 1 event

OTHERS

Section "Rising"

Eligibility: Teacher's teaching experience is 5 years or less

• Events: WTF CSR

• Entry Limit: 1 student per teacher per event

Rounds: Preliminaries & FinalEntry Fee: 8,000 yen / 1 event

Section "Doubles"

• Eligibility: Open (students can participate with each other)

• Events: CSRJ

- Entry Limit: 1 student per teacher per event
- Rounds: Preliminaries & FinalEntry Fee: 8,000 yen / 1 event
- Duplication of participation with "Beginners" and "Leaders" is not permitted.

Section "Leaders"

- Eligibility: Leader students
- Events: WT CR
- Entry Limit: 1 student per teacher per event
- Rounds: Preliminaries & FinalEntry Fee: 8,000 yen / 1 event
- Duplication of participation with "Beginners" and "Doubles" is not permitted.

Section "Beginners"

- Eligibility: Student's dance experience is less than 2 years
- Events: WT CR
- Entry Limit: 1 student per teacher per event
- Rounds: Preliminaries & FinalEntry Fee: 5,000 yen / 1 event
- Duplication of participation with "Leaders" and "Doubles" is not permitted.

JUNIOR

Section "Juvenile Pair Division"

- Eligibility: Under 12 years old at the time of the event
- Events: WTFQ CSRJ
- Rounds: Preliminaries & Final
- Entry Fee: 1,000 yen / 1 event
- A guardian's consent form must be submitted.
- Duplication of participation in Juvenile and Junior sections is not permitted.
- When partners are in different ages, the higher age will be applied.

Section "Juvenile Solo Division"

- Eligibility: Under 12 years old on the day of the event
- Events: WTFQ CSRJ
- Rounds: Preliminaries & Final
- Entry Fee: 1,000 yen / 1 event
- A guardian's consent form must be submitted.
- Duplication of participation in Juvenile and Junior sections is not permitted.

Section "Junior Pair Division"

- Eligibility: Under 15 years old on the day of the event
- Events: WTFQ CSRJ

- Rounds: Preliminaries & Final
- Entry Fee: 1,000 yen / 1 event
- A guardian's consent form must be submitted.
- Duplication of participation in Juvenile and Junior sections is not permitted.
- When partners are in different ages, the higher age will be applied.

Section "Junior Solo Division"

- Eligibility: Under 15 years old on the day of the event
- Events: WTFQ CSRJ
- Rounds: Preliminaries & Final
- Entry Fee: 1,000 yen / 1 event
- A guardian's consent form must be submitted.
- Duplication of participation in Juvenile and Junior sections is not permitted.

AMA

Section "World Amateur Exhibition Match"

- Eligibility: Amateur dancers worldwide (The first 30 couples)
- Events: WTFQVw CSRPJ 5 dances combined
- Rounds: 4 rounds
- Entry Fee: 10,000 yen
- Duplication of participation in Latin and Ballroom is not permitted.

Sections where duplication of participation is not permitted:

- Juvenile Solo Division and Junior Solo Division
- Juvenile Pair Division and Junior Pair Division
- Beginners, Leaders, and Doubles
- S&T Multi Dance Latin and Ballroom
- S&T Scholarship Latin and Ballroom
- World Amateur Exhibition Match Latin and Ballroom

Application details

1. **Application period starts**: August 1st (Fri.),10:00 AM Please apply using the entry form (from Here or on this website)

*For the "S&T Scholarship" and "S&T Multi Dance" sections, if over 24 entries are registered on August 1st (the first day entries open), we will hold a lottery and notify the results promptly. Entries will continue to be accepted after August 2nd until the number reaches 24

2. **Application deadline**: September 30th (Tue.) 11:00 PM Please note that the number of entries may be limited due to event management reasons.

3. Participation fee payment deadline

An email regarding the invoice will be sent to applicants. Please make your payment using the designated method by the deadline. Applications will be invalidated for any reason if payment is not received/confirmed.

Changes or cancellations to your application due to personal reasons will be accepted until October 23rd (Thu.) 11:59 PM. Please note that cancellations made after this deadline are not eligible for a refund of the entry fee.

Notes on Application:

- 1. For applications, the supervising teacher is the person responsible for the application, and payment should be made under the name of the person responsible for the application.
- 2. For Junior and Amateur participants, the representative is the person responsible for the application, and payment should be made under the name of the person responsible for the application.
- 3. For multiple entries, please make a lump sum payment under the name of the person responsible for the application. (Transfer fees are borne by the applicant.)
- 4. Please bear the transfer fees.
- 5. The bank transfer statement will serve as your receipt.

Notes on Competition:

- 1. To participate, please thoroughly read and agree to the application terms and conditions before applying.
- 2. Participants should take care of their health and prepare for the competition.
- 3. In each section, participants will be called by their bib number. Please pay attention to avoid being late.
- 4. If you enter the wrong heat, you will not be subject to judging.
- 5. Warming up or practicing in a way that may disturb others in the venue is prohibited.
- 6. Changing rooms are for changing only; please manage your belongings yourself.
- 7. First aid will be provided for accidents occurring during the event, but we will not be held responsible thereafter. Please ensure thorough self-management.

Notes on Venue:

- 1. Lost items found will be kept at Hikarie Hall.
- 2. Eating and drinking while walking in the competition venue are prohibited.
- 3. Please take your trash home with you.

- 4. The organizer is not responsible for any troubles, accidents, or injuries that occur within the venue.
