28 DAY VALIDATION OF FOREIGN PILOTS LICENSES FOR PRIVATE DAY VFR FLYING / RECREATIONAL FLYING (PART 61, 62, 68 AND 69)

1. Applicability

The South African Civil Aviation Regulations (SACAR) of 2011 (As amended) is applicable.

This general notice is applicable to all applications for foreign pilot licenses for private day VFR flying and recreational holiday flying for a period not exceeding 28 days. This notice will be applicable to CAR Part 61, 62, 68 and 69 (PPL, NPL, Gliders and Balloons respectively).

2. Purpose of this General Notice

This General Notice seeks to complement and enhance the objectives of Part 61.01.13 (23), 62.01.15 (11), 68.01.9 (11) and 69.01.9 (11). This notice prescribes the requirements for validating foreign pilots licenses for private day VFR flying and recreational flying, for a period not exceeding 28 days.

3. Requirements

Prior to arrival:

- Apply for a short term validation 60 days prior to arrival to afford enough time for verification of the license with the country of issue.
- Pay the applicable fee as per Part 187.

On arrival:

- Conduct a Competency Check with a Gr I, Gr II Flight instructor or DFE.
- Receive a briefing covering local radio procedures, Air Law aspects, airspaces and density altitude.

The following documents to be submitted for the issuance of the validation certificate:

- Letter confirming date of arrival and departure and details of aircraft to be used.
- Application form (CA 61.01.15).
- Certified copy of valid foreign license.
- Certified copy of valid foreign medical.
- Certified copy of valid passport.
- Certified copy of logbook (last three pages inclusive of competency check endorsement).

An applicant who meets the above requirements may be issued with a 28 day validation for private day VFR flying / recreational flying (Part 61, 62, 68 and 69), as applicable.
