



Two day online conference on accessibility, disability justice, and anti-ableism

350+ attendees

What did I learn?

Personal interest X accessibility Youth want to become engaged when they feel engaged *with*!

What makes an online event good is the same as in-person events, but the stakes can be higher!

Technology requirements & 'zoom fatigue/burnout' Online platforms offer unique paths to accessibility...




