Master's Thesis in Clinical Nutrition

'Diet induced ketosis for patients with brain injury - A Feasibility Study, A Ketogenic diet with MCT supplementation as a potential treatment for adult patients with brain injury'

My Master's Thesis projects was a clinical trial that I solely initiated, planned and executed.

I wrote the study protocol and prepared the project budget, sent applications to the ethical committee and data protection agency and applied for funds and sponsorships which covered all of the study expenses. I also planned the intervention, which included producing ketogenic recipes for the hospital kitchen and finding supplementary food products for occupational therapy. I included the maximum amount of patients for the study in 3 months. I assessed the patients nutrient and fluid needs daily and compiled their daily individual meal plan. I took glucose and ketone measurements of the patients three times daily and assessed their wellbeing and adverse events. One a week I performed bioelectrical impedance analysis on all the patients. I organised and performed all parts of the study and worked very closely with medical doctors, physiotherapists, occupational therapists and the kitchen staff.

The results of the study have been presented at 7th Global Symposium on Medical Ketogenic Dietary Therapies, Brighton, UK in October 2021 and will be presented at The 5th Annual Metabolic Health Summit, Los Angeles, USA, in May 2022. We are now in the publication process.
