 - Notifications to finalists will be sent by **June 30, 2025**.
 - Final round **results will be announced ON-SITE** on July 7, 2025.

1. Eligibility and Overview

The Elaine & Andrew Daniluk Florida Young Artists International Piano Competition is open to pianists of all nationalities aged 4 to 18. Participants are divided into age-based categories.

Preliminary screening is based on video submissions. Final rounds are held in Asia, Europe, and the U.S.

Winners from the Asia Chapter will be determined at the final round held on July 7, 2025, and first prize winners will be invited to perform at the **Winner's Concert with Orchestra in Miami, Florida on August 31, 2025**.

 - **Venue:** Sakura Hall, Manabi-no-Mori Exchange Center, Uozu City, Toyama, Japan

2. Application Deadline and Repertoire

- **Deadline:** June 25, 2025, 11:59 PM (Japan Standard Time)
- Preliminary video screening results: **June 28, 2025**
- Finalist notifications: **June 30, 2025**
- No additional fees are required to participate in the final round.

3. Video Submission Requirements

Submit a YouTube video clearly showing the applicant's **profile, hands, and feet**.

Proper concert attire is required.

4. Required Documents

Submit one of the following, along with a short bio, headshot, and proof of age:

- Birth certificate
 - Government-issued ID or driver's license
 - Passport

5. Repertoire Requirements (One Movement Only)

- **Junior:** up to age 12
- **Senior:** age 13–18

Recommended composers: **Bach, Haydn, Beethoven, Mozart, Chopin, Grieg**

- Performances can be with orchestra or second piano (within past 6 months).
 - Final round will use **two pianos**.
 - **Memorization required.**
 - Accompanists must be arranged by participants.
 - Official accompanist available by request: **¥20,000** (includes rehearsal the day before).

Include in video description: Name, Title, Composer, Age, Category, Duration

Video must be public or unlisted.

By participating, you waive any rights to financial compensation for video usage.

Judges' decisions are **final and non-negotiable**.

8. Awards and Prizes

Junior Division

- 🏆 1st: \$400 + Orchestra performance in Miami
- 🥈 2nd: \$200
- 🥉 3rd: \$100

Senior Division

- 🏆 1st: \$600 + Orchestra performance in Miami
 - 🥈 2nd: \$300
 - 🥉 3rd: \$150
 - Diplomas for outstanding performers
 - Certificates for finalists, semifinalists, and teachers (upon request)
 - **Previous winners may reapply**
