exist in numerous color variants: Animals with black as well as yellow-, dark- and light brown thorax.

The abdomen can be black on the 1st and 3rd tergites with few grayish yellowish hairs, but also - like the last 3rd tergites completely light yellow. The last tergites 4 - 5 - 6 can be brownish or light yellow. Brownish colored variants of B. humilis can easily be confused with Bombus pascuorum or B. muscorum. Distribution throughout Europe: open landscapes, forest edges, flower-rich meadows, unmown roadside banks, roadsides. Almost exclusively in natural landscapes, rarely near settlements.
