

Gastronomic recommendations

Baiersbronn star chefs have helped the national park community to culinary world fame with their Michelin stars. A few years ago, Baiersbronn was named the gourmet capital of Germany.

If you do not want to "reach for the stars" right away but are simply looking for a good place to stop in Baiersbronn, we are happy to give you our favorites on the way. As always, however, this is purely a matter of taste.

1 Hotel Sonne, Röt (1,5 km): - Currently only open to house guests. Lunch might be possible.

Despite its size, it is a very cozy restaurant with fabulous salad buffet and very good Swabian cuisine.

2 Da Bino, Schönmünzsch (5 km):

The small restaurant is a bit inconspicuous from the outside (located opposite "Taxi Batsch"), but it is worth to give it a go. Pizza and pasta are insanely good. Monique does her utmost to make all her guests happy.

A previous call definitely makes sense, because in good weather the terrace is quickly full. And by the way: The pizzas are gigantic with 36 cm ø!

Our tip for you: Please pay attention ordering spicy / hot dishes. The chef really means it. 😊

Fancy discovering **something new**? Then take a look at the Landgasthof Schützen in Klosterreichenbach. Even if the name doesn't give it away: Here you can discover the authentic and **aromatic cuisine of Tunisia**, which will transport you to the Mediterranean for a brief moment. The menu ranges from **couscous** to fruity **shakshuka**, various **tajines** (vegetarian, with fresh fish, lamb, etc.) and delicious dishes with **frutti di mare**.

Karim prepares the dishes with a lot of love and is happy to adapt the spiciness or ingredients to your own taste.

German dishes can also be found at Landgasthof Schützen, but if you fancy schnitzel, roast beef and the like, then take a look at item 10 on this list.

Whether fine cuisine in the “Meierei”, or a little more rustic in the rustic “Hofscheuer” the Waldknechtshof is worth a visit.

In addition to many regional classics, such as Wurstsalat, **Maultaschen**, Kässpätzle, etc., you will also find some specialties on the menu. For example, you can get “**steaks from the hot stone**” every day, and on Fridays and Saturdays there are fresh **baked potatoes** from the “**Victorian Baking Oven**”. Bakeries:

The selection of bakeries in Baiersbronn is actually very large. So we just want to give you the nearest shopping opportunities:

- the small farm market of the Riegraf family – here you can get fresh bread or rolls on Fridays and Saturdays.
- Branch of the Ziegler bakery in Klosterreichenbach – which, by the way, is also open on Sundays
- „Jules Lädle“ in Huzenbach

Bakery sales cart on Saturdays:

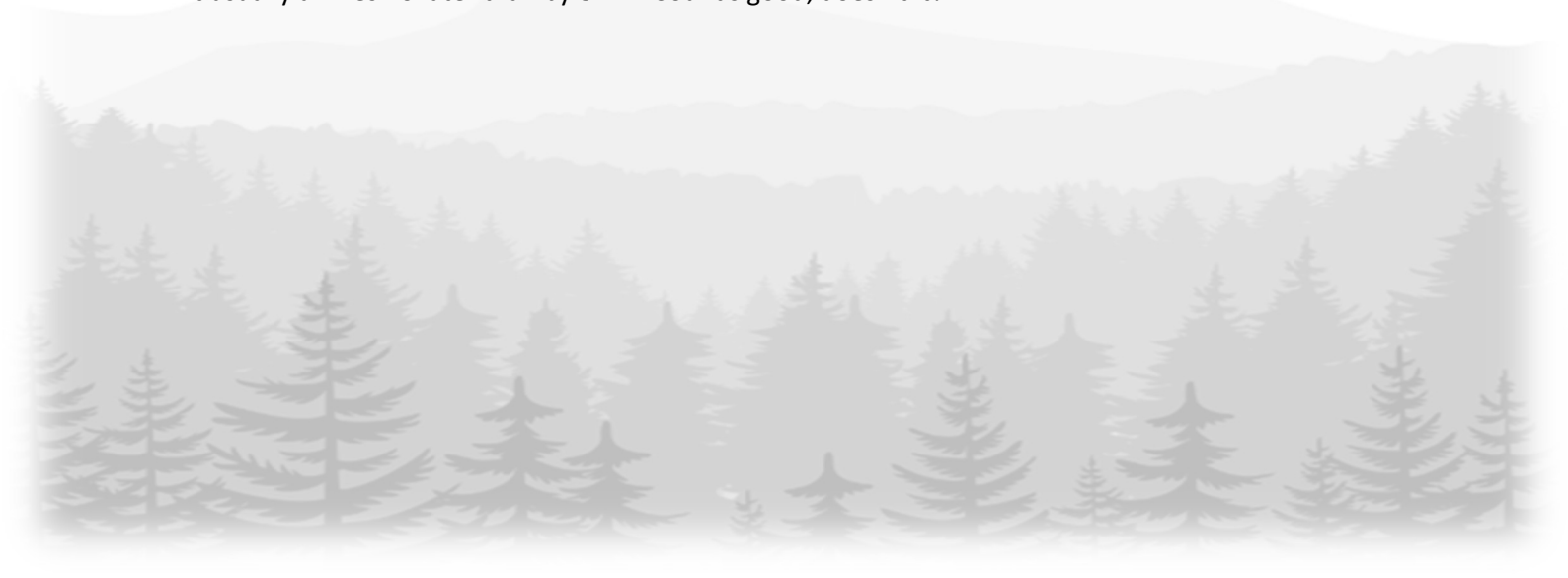
If you fancy fresh bread or rolls, you can shop on Saturdays at the sales cart of the bakery Klumpp from Baiersbronn (watch out for a white van). It usually passes the SchwarzWild at around 09:15 AM. By the way: It only stops when needed. Wild waving of both hands helps. 😊

Bread roll service:

For self-catering, the so called “Brezel Taxi” from Enzklosterle offers a bread service on weekends. Closing date for orders is 5 PM the day before. You can find the “Brezel Taxi” on the Internet at:
