Barbara can you explain BERNABA 2025 to us?

BERNABA is an important national and multilateral stamp exhibition at level I. The multilateral includes seven countries: Germany, Austria, Liechtenstein, Luxembourg, Slovenia, the Netherlands and Switzerland. At the same time, we are celebrating the 175th anniversary of the first Swiss federal stamps, Ortspost, Poste Locale and Rayon.

What is your role in the OC? I am responsible for the secre-

tariat and take care of the organisation of events and workshops.

Who can take part in the exhibition?

Basically, anyone who is a

member of an association that belongs to one of the seven multilateral countries and has qualified for level I.

What special exhibitions are planned?

To commemorate the 175th anniversary, we are presenting a special exhibition on the Durheim issues. A special highlight is the exhibition of a selection from The Royal Philatelic Collection, the private philatelic collection of King Charles III. There is also the 20th international competition class of UPU 2025, in which post offices show their best collections and innovations.

You also need sponsors for an exhibition: What do you offer the sponsors?

We offer various sponsorship packages, from patrons to major sponsors. For example, visitors can purchase a hard copy of the exhibition catalogue with a pin for a small contribution. Metal sponsors benefit from pins, mentions in the exhibition guide and on the website through to exhibition frames and entry to the Palmares evening. Sponsors can relax and enjoy refreshments in our VIP lounge. Special mention should be made of the event sponsors who finance workshops and receive an exclusive presence. As our main partner, we have already been able to gain **Corinphila**, which we are very pleased about.

Which postal organisations have registered?

So far, Switzerland with a large stand, Liechtenstein, Austria

and the UPU have registered.

What about dealer participation?

We are expecting numerous dealers. In addition, various working groups will be on site to present their specific subject areas.

What events are on offer? We traditionally open with an opening ceremony. There are various lectures during the exhibition, and the 'Palmares' gala takes place on the penultimate evening.

Are there also offers for non-philatelists?

Yes, there will be workshops where visitors can get active themselves, for example in paper making, lithography or calligraphy. We also offer daily carriage rides in a historic stagecoach in front of the exhibition centre. There will also be QR codes throughout the exhibition, which visitors can use to call up audio information on various topics.

What about the literature?

To mark the anniversary, Dr Andreas Disteli will publish a book on the Durheim editions, accompanied by your book on Karl Durheim. In addition, further works will be published and will be available in a guarded literature corner of the exhibition, where visitors can look through the new and competing books.

Are long-term goals also being pursued?

Yes, with the workshops and special exhibitions we hope to awaken the understanding and interest of non-philatelists. Our aim is to make the exhibition interesting for a wide audience.

What are the biggest challenges in organising such a large exhibition today?

The biggest challenge is putting together a motivated team for the organising committee. The exhibition requires a lot of effort and dedicated volunteers. Funding is also an issue, as ambitious projects often require additional sponsors. Finally, it is a major task to appeal not only to traditional philatelists but also to a broad public.
