Melinda will share her research on Irish Men's Sheds that she conducted as a Fulbright Scholar. She visited 14 different sheds and conducted 37 interviews with shed members to learn more about why older men participated in Men's Sheds and why they remain actively engaged in them. Upon returning to the U.S., she and a colleague created a documentary to help share the stories of Irish shed members. The documentary was selected for inclusion in the Catalyst International Film Festival in Limerick, Ireland. She will share her research on Irish Men's Sheds and discuss her work with U.S. Men's Sheds, including how she started the first Men's Shed in Iowa.

Her research interests include exploring outlets that bring purpose and meaning to the lives of older adults. In 2018, she led a study abroad program to Ireland with undergraduate students and visited a Men's Shed in Dundalk. This sparked her interest and enthusiasm for Men's Sheds and in 2022 she returned to Ireland as a Fulbright Scholar to study Irish Men's Sheds in County Limerick.
