From trainings of classical-technical singing in Saarbrücken to the jazz school DJAM in Amsterdam, lessons in Hindustani vocals in Mumbai and master classes and workshops with Meredith Monk, Shelley Hirsch, Gabriele Hasler, Sainkho Namtschylak and Frank Köllges, Sascha creates her very own style, which she pursues as a continuous research in the areas of sound and visual expression. www.saschaley.com

MURAT ÖZTÜRK is a pianist and composer. His French-Italian-Turkish background immersed him early on in the enormous European culture that has been developing in East and West for centuries. After discovering jazz through the music of Bill Evans, Oscar Peterson and Keith Jarrett, he studied at the Bill Evans Piano Academy in Paris. Encounters with musicians such as Bernard Maury, Clare Fischer and Michel Petrucciani led him closer and closer to jazz, in which he established himself as a subtle virtuoso.

LAURENT PAYFERT is a French double bass player and composer. He studied classical music at the Conservatoire de Musique in Metz and started playing in rock and funk bands and began later to explore both jazz and improvisation. Encounters with Hein Van De Geyn, Ricardo Del Fra and Steve Lacy, among others have influenced his personal style.
