Akita International University, AIU, is a four-year liberal arts university located in Akita prefecture in the Tohoku region of northern Japan. AIU is a public university corporation established in April 2004 by the local prefectural government, which has bachelor's programs in Global Business, Global Studies, and Global Connectivity.

The undergraduate program at AIU offers all subject matter courses taught in English, only, the first program in Japan to do so. In addition, we have partnerships with 200 universities in 51 countries and regions such as U.S.A, Australia, Canada, France, Germany, UK and Singapore, and all students are required to study abroad, outside Japan, for one year.

AIU has been recognized as one of the top universities in Japan for its uniqueness and innovative approach. Since its establishment in 2004, the university has been highly regarded and received constant attention from the public.

**4) Scholarship**

Eligible undergraduate students may receive a tuition reduction depending on their grades.

1st year students: 30% tuition reduction

2nd, 3rd and 4th year students with excellent academic performance: 40% or 50% tuition reduction depending on their academic performance

In addition to the tuition reduction, HOSEI provides various internal scholarships such as HOSEI International Fund (HIF) International Student Scholarship offering from 200,000 JPY or 250,000 JPY per year. See the details [here](#).

All applicants are eligible to apply for [APU's Tuition Reduction Scholarship](#). There are five levels of tuition reduction: 100%, 80%, 65%, 50%, or 30%, which will last for all four years of study.
