


Study in Japan Fairs provided useful informatoin and interactions in Uganda and in Kenya

Study in Japan for Africa hosted a series of events in September and October, providing information on university applications and scholarships. Japanese universities open applications one year to eight months prior to the September/October admission period. Such events were, therefore, timely.

In September, two Study in Japan Fairs were held in Uganda and Kenya, as well as Study in Japan seminars at four high schools and at Ashinaga Uganda, which is an international NGO that provides financial support to orphaned children. In October, the activities moved to online to meet more people including those from West and Southern Africa. Two online fairs were organized – one on undergraduate studies and the other on postgraduate studies.



At these events, participants and Japanese universities actively interacted, discussing programs and scholarship applications. The **Future Global Leadership (FGL) Program** at **Tohoku University** is an innovative and dynamic educational initiative designed to cultivate the next generation of global

leaders. This program consists of three dedicated courses taught completely in English. The scientific areas of study include "**International Mechanical and Aerospace Engineering**", "**Advanced Molecular Chemistry**," and "**Applied Marine Biolog**y". The FGL program focuses on Interdisciplinary Learning, Cultural Diversity, Research and Innovation, and Leadership Development. It is fostering a Global Network of young scientists to prepare them to navigate an increasingly interconnected world. To help meet student needs, Tohoku University also offers **a wide range of scholarships and financial aid**, including the MEXT Scholarship (University Recommendation), the President's Fellowship, the Honors Scholarship, and others.

TOYO in TOKYO

Toyo University, located in Tokyo, the capital city in Japan, has Faculty of Global and Regional Studies. It is composed of two departments (Global Innovation Studies and Regional Development Studies) with different focuses of interdisciplinary study.

Department of Global Innovation Studies offers three strands of study: Global Collaboration, Global Business, and Global Entrepreneurship. The department emphasizes the idea of being an innovative problem solver with sophisticated skills of creativity, problem-solving, communication, and language. Therefore, in all strands, students can study economics, business, environmental and social issues, and other topic in a multilateral way. All courses are taught in English. **Department of Regional Development Studies** focuses on international relations, community development, environment, information, infrastructure, and other related fields. Students can choose either English or Japanese track.

In both programs, **full scholarship** called Toyo SDGs Ambassador Program is available. It covers **60-100% tuition** and **full housing fee for four years**. Toyo is looking for students who are interested in achieving the 17 goals for sustainable development set by the United Nations.

Bachelor Courses at Ritsumeikan University

No Japanese proficiency required for admission: Ritsumeikan University pioneers new English-medium undergraduate degree programs utilizing Japan's well-developed educational resources. The University currently offers five English-medium undergraduate programs in the following fields: Global Liberal Arts/Asia-Pacific Affairs, International Relations, Policy Science, and Information Science and Engineering. Among these offerings are dual/joint undergraduate degree programs, in which students can earn undergraduate degrees from both Ritsumeikan and partner universities abroad. **Tuition Reduction Scholarships**: International students (who hold the visa status of residence of [Student] while studying at RU) are awarded at least a 20% reduction, with 50% and 100% reduction offered to the most outstanding applicants. *The Tuition Reduction Scheme is confirmed up to 2024 and is subject to change in subsequent years.

What is JDS? The webinar is coming soon to explain all about it. In a nutshell, JDS is

- a full covered scholarship program funded by the Japanese government;
- for **government officials** of **Kenya** and **Senegal** to study at Japanese universities in English to obtain a master's degree. For Kenyan candidates, doctoral courses may also be covered;
- which aims to contribute to the improvement of public administrative capacity.

Study in Japan for Africa, collaborating with JDS JICE Project Office in Kenya and Senegal, will be hosting an online information session on Saturday 11 November. The session will provide the information on the JDS application procedure, courses offered by JDS and career paths after graduation from Japanese universities. Although JDS is set to a specific group of people in Kenya and Senegal, the session is open for everyone.
