GREEN FINANCE AS A KEY DRIVER FOR SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT IN THE AMAZON

RATIONALE

Amazon Week 2025 marks the third edition of a program focused on highlighting the critical role of the world's largest rainforest in maintaining global climate balance, protecting biodiversity, and promoting sustainable development.

This year's events in Berlin, Brussels, and Paris carry special significance as they build momentum toward the UN Climate Change Conference (COP30), set to take place in Belem, a Brazilian city in the Amazon region, in November 2025.

Finance is a central theme of Amazon Week 2025. A solid financial architecture is essential to tackling both the climate and biodiversity crises. The discussions will focus on mobilizing and allocating resources effectively to the Amazon region, enhancing mechanisms for climate and biodiversity finance, and aligning financial flows with sustainable development objectives.

The event on green finance in the Embassy of Brazil in Berlin is targeted at international investors (asset owners, asset managers, investment advisors, and public benefit-oriented companies) and aims to highlight initiatives seeking to drive sustainable investments in the Amazon. In particular, it will focus on scaling activities related to nature-based solutions and bioeconomy.

The event will conclude with a networking cocktail, allowing speakers and investors to engage directly.
