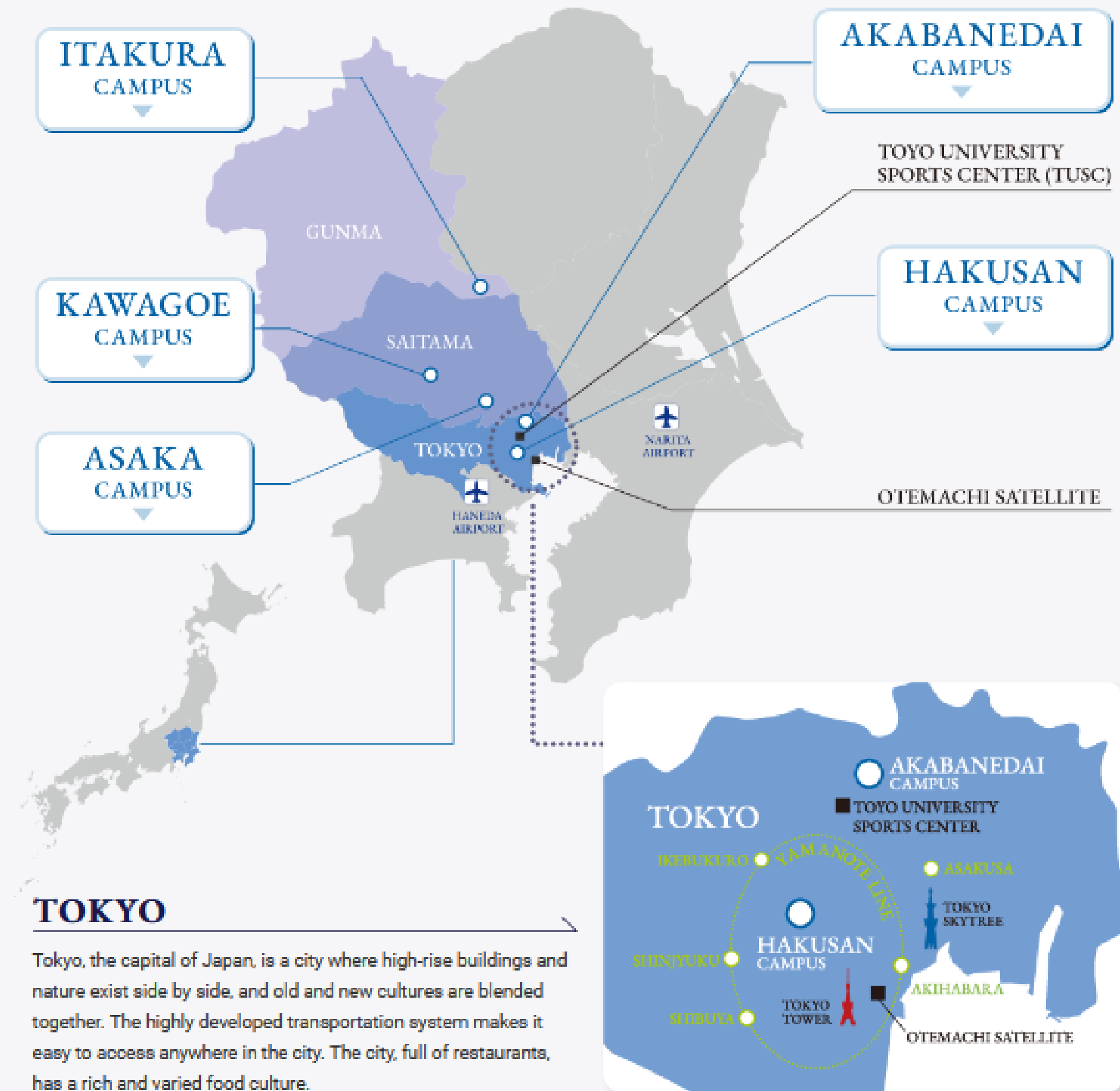

Toyo and SDGs

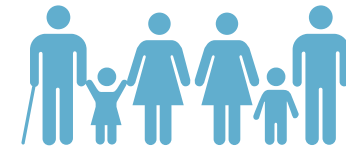

Learning

SDGs Ambassadors should be eager to learn different subjects and have keen interests in solving social, economic and political issues existing in the world.



Educating

In order for Toyo University to help the world achieve the goals, the Ambassadors will be the leading body to educate people in Toyo's community. They are expected to hold events, seminars, or study groups that will be opportunities to learn about the SDGs and the sustainable future.



Leading

The Ambassadors are expected to lead Toyo's community so that Toyo can achieve the goals. They will also be the leading figures in realizing the sustainable future for the next generations.



Toyo SDGs Ambassador Scholarship for International Students

(Undergraduate students only)

To accept outstanding students with keen interests in the SDGs and related fields, Toyo University offers a generous scholarship package to selected students.

While there are financial benefits, the Ambassadors have unique obligations and roles that they should fulfill.

Tuition waiver (Full or partial)

Tuition and other fees will be waived 100% for the first year. From the second year, the percentage will be 60–100% depending upon GPA.*

Accommodation provided

Housing for the Ambassadors is provided by Toyo University for 4 years.

On-campus part-time job opportunities

Ambassadors will be hired as Student Assistants by the University and help teachers run their classroom teaching.

SDGs Activity Support

Each Ambassador will have his/her own advisor, who will oversee SDGs-related activities and give advice.

*60% of the tuitions and fees are waived by the SDGs Ambassador scholarship and the rest by the Tuition Reduction Scholarship. The latter is intended to help self-funded international students with financial difficulty.

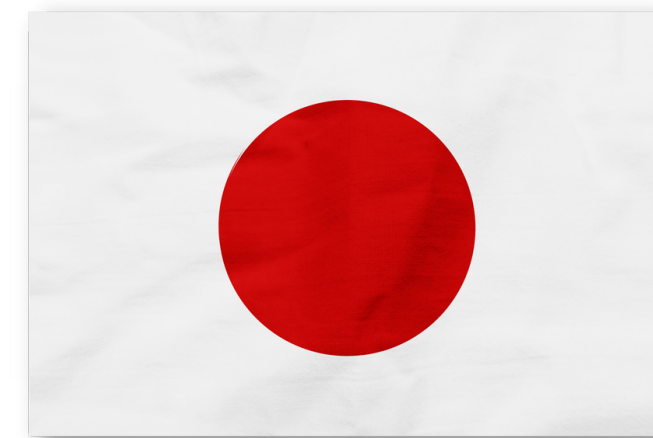
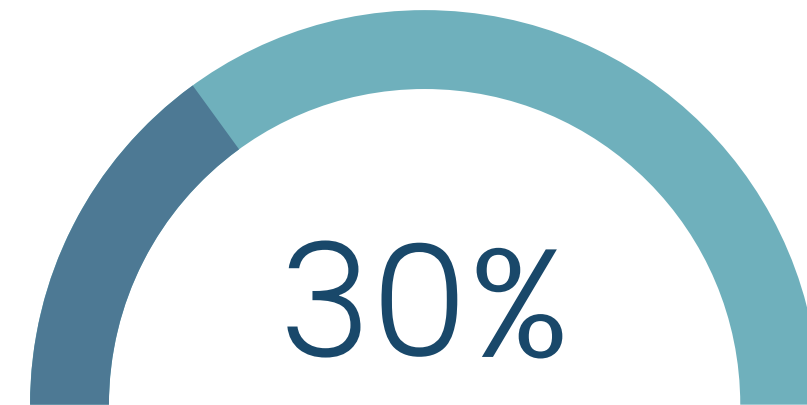

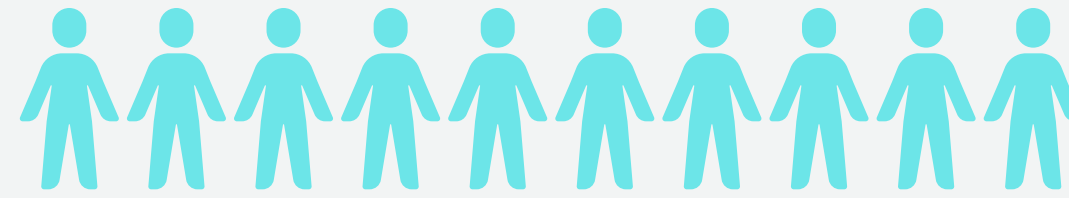
Some Important Notes:

Although Ambassador's tuition and fees are waived 100%, he/she still needs to pay 30% when they enroll in Toyo University. That is reimbursed at the end of the first year.

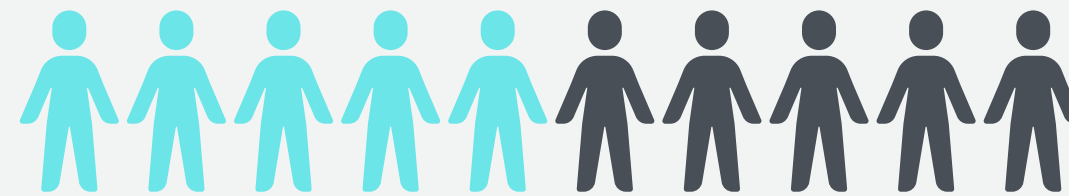
Even though students in English-track program can complete the course work only in English, they will be required to study the Japanese language in the course of their study. To get a job in Japan, having advanced level of Japanese is highly encouraged.



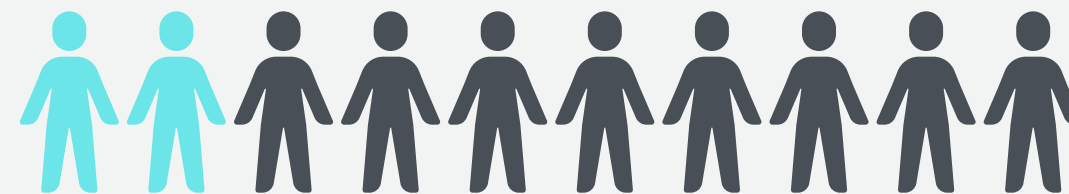
How to Be Selected



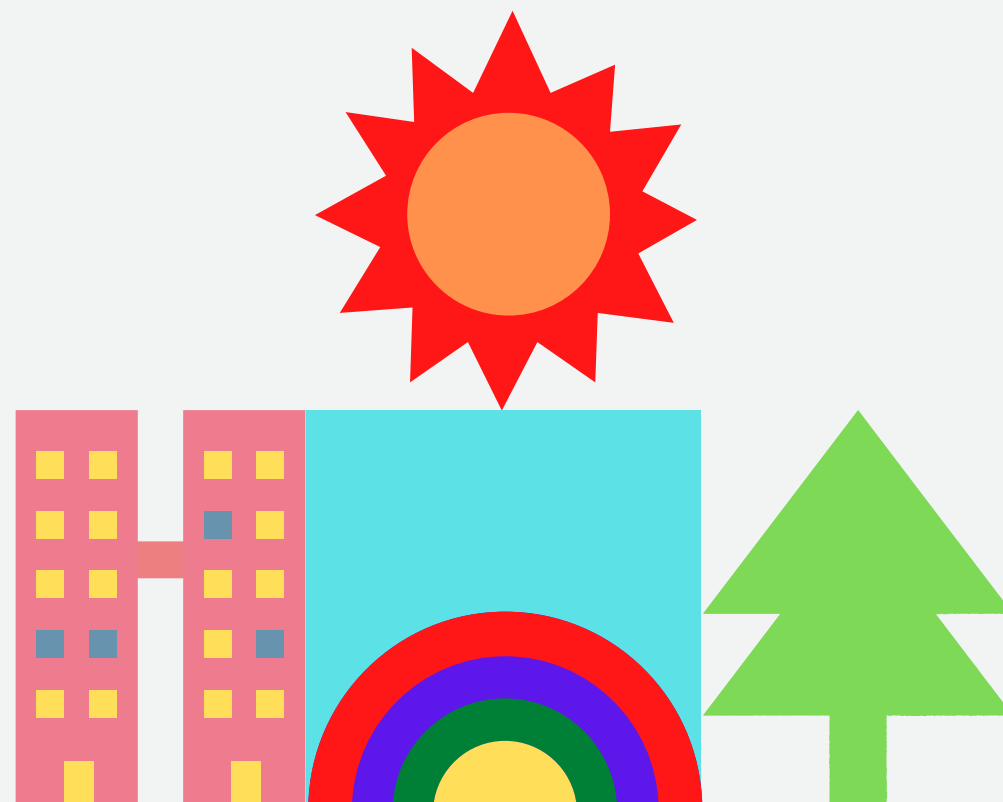
Apply for admission

Application Eligibility for the Admission

Please refer to the
Application Guide for details.

Is a national of a country other than Japan.

Has completed a 12-year school education or holds a college entrance certificate such as International Baccalaureate

OR

Has completed a school education that is regarded as equivalent to a 12-year education by Japan's Ministry of Education

Language requirements:

English track: TOEFL iBT 79, IELTS 6.0, TOEIC L&R 780

Japanese track:

Generally EJU 300 or JLPT N2 but depends on departments (see the Application Guide)

Application Eligibility for the SDGs Ambassador Scholarship

SDGs Ambassadors will be selected from the applicants who have passed the admission for the department that accommodates the Ambassador AND meet the requirements listed here:

International students who are willing to contribute to help the global society achieve the SDGs in various ways

International students who can actively host or participate in activities – inside or outside of Toyo University – that promote SDGs or globalization

International students with high proficiency in English

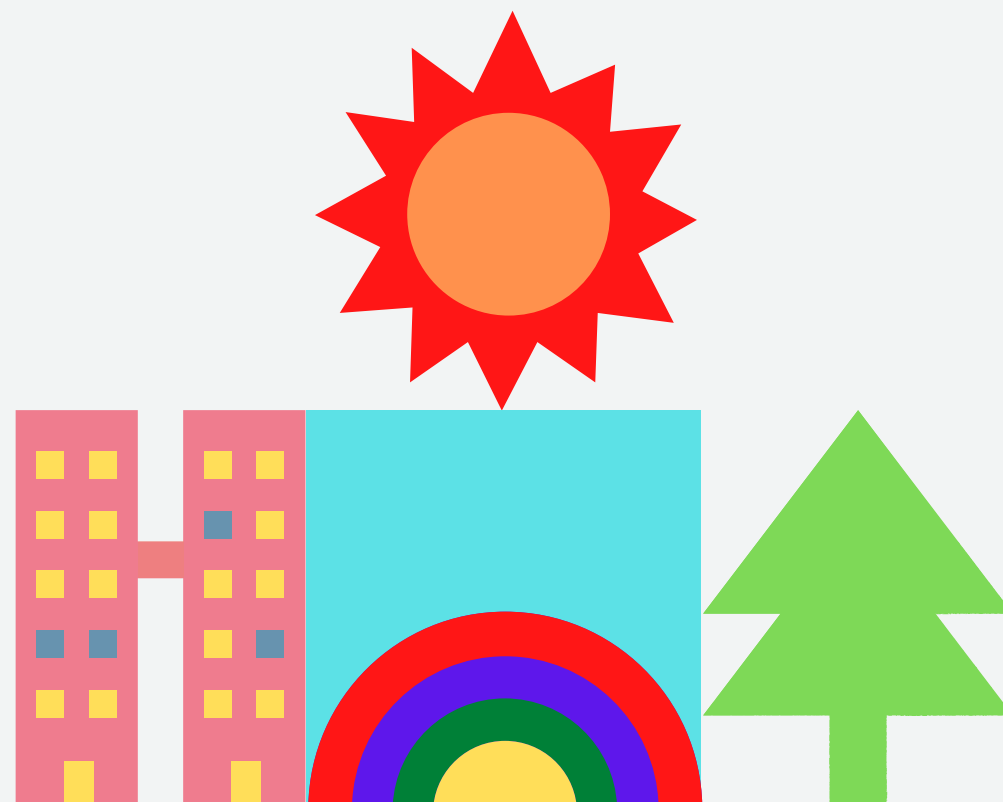
International students who have clear career plans before and after graduation

Language requirements

English track: TOEFL iBT 94, IELTS 6.5, TOEIC L&R 780 and SW 310

Japanese track: TOEFL iBT 79, IELTS 6.0, TOEIC L&R 780,

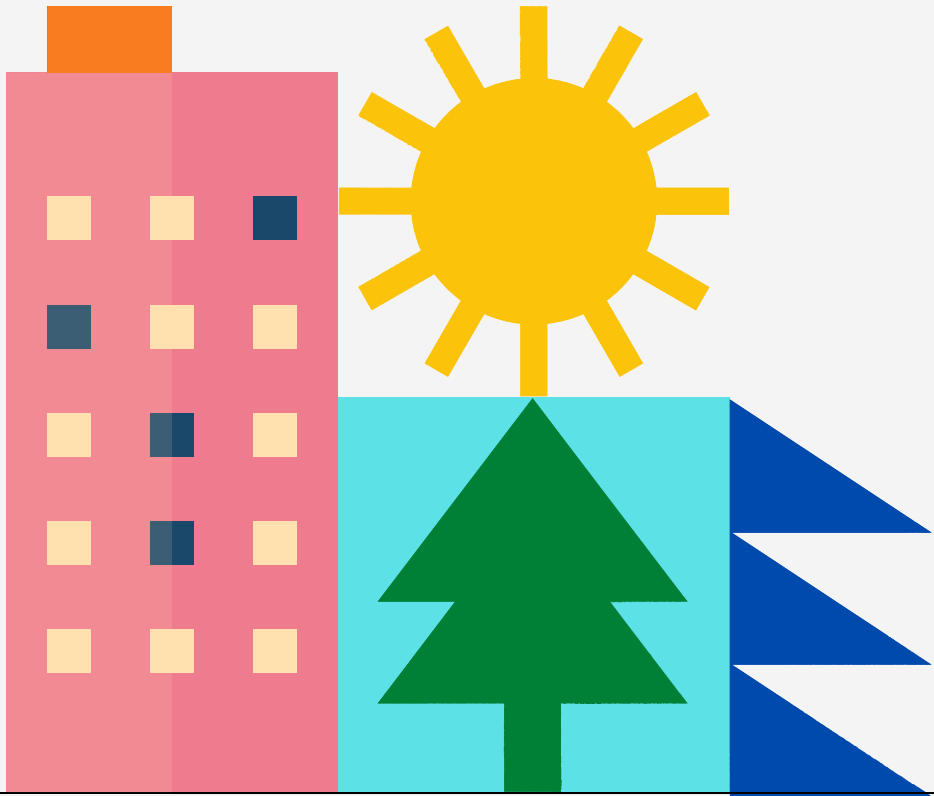

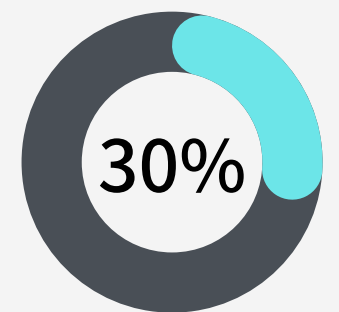
Other Financial Support
