
- No net emissions of greenhouse gases by 2050
- Economic growth decoupled from resource use
- No person and no place left behind





Progress on tackling climate change

The EU is a global leader in the fight against climate change:





Between 1990 and 2018, greenhouse gas emissions decreased by 23%, while the economy grew by 61%



First climate initiatives

- European Climate Law:
 - 2050 climate-neutrality objective in EU law
 - 2030 emissions reduction target towards 55%
- 2 European Climate Pact to engage citizens and all parts of society in climate action

30% of InvestEU to projects that fight climate change




