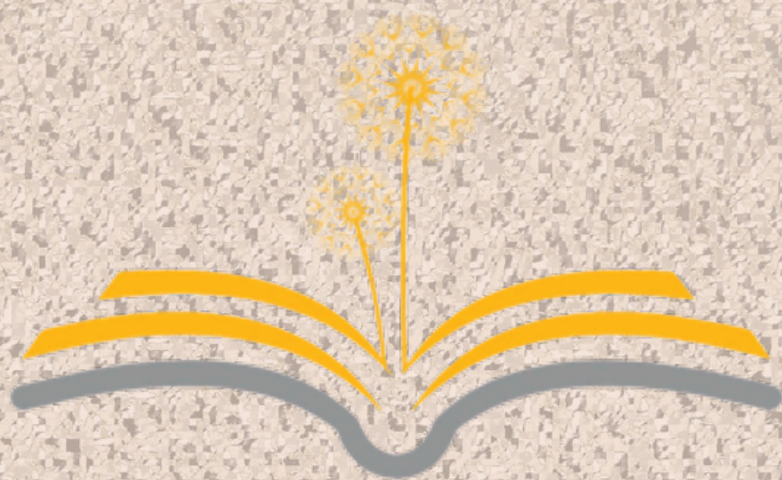
Imaginers

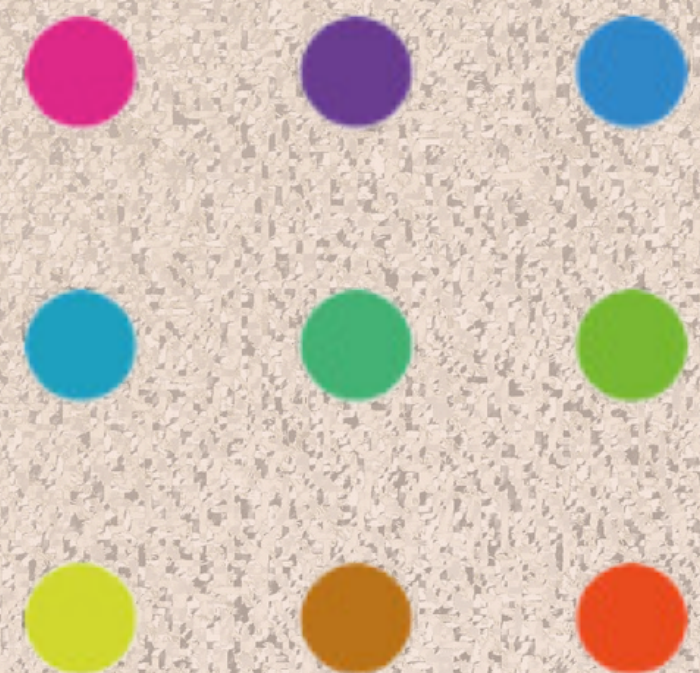
Entertainers
