

Family Sand Beach in Cala Blava

In 5 walking minutes distance you reach a beautiful sandy beach with almost only locals. The beach is also ideal for children, as the water is calm and clear and you can always keep an eye on the little ones.






In only 2 walking minutes you reach a small bay with deep blue water and cozy lying areas. From the terrace of Casa Pura you have a direct view down to this bay.





If you turn right when leaving the house, you reach within 3 walking minutes another bay which is really nice for taking a swim. It's also the ideal start to a relaxed tour on the water with stand-up paddle boards. Best in the morning, when the water is still calm and no winds are blowing.






Boards can be rented for 100 € per board and week
