



2. PREPARE


STEP 1

Remove the OEM roof rails from the vehicle.

Simply pull on the plastics to expose the bolts.

Use fig.2.1 as reference.




STEP 2

Remove all bolts and take off the OEM roof rails. Put them aside and store in a safe place.

Fig 2.2 is for reference.

STEP 3


With the ditch exposed, clean area well around all 6 holes with alcohol based cleaner. Use a cloth to wipe away any unwanted debris.

After cleaning, make sure area is dry. Apply sealant around all the holes.



2. FIT & SECURE




STEP 4

Using "PARTS 06, 07 & 08", fasten to the roof onto sealant applied in previous step. Fully fasten with 2 x M8 Cap Screws, 2 x M8 Spring Washers and 2 x M8 Washers on each part.

Fasten FRONT, MIDDEL and REAR Brackets (Indicated on bracket).




STEP 5

Turn all 8 x "PART 04"s over and align "PART 05" as shown in Fig 2.4, lightly tighten bolts and nuts. Do this on both ends of "PARTS 04"

Fasteners used: 4 x (M8 x 16 Hex Bolts), 4 x (M8 Washers) and 4 x (M8 Lock Nuts). [PER PART 04]

STEP 6


Fasten "previous assembly" to "PART 01" & "PART 02" with 2 x (M8 x 16 Button heads), 2 x (M8 Washers) and 2 x (M8 Lock Nuts) on each side. Repeat process on all 8 load bars.


STEP 11

Fasten "Wind Deflector" to the rack already assembled in previous step.

Fasten with 2 x (M6 x 16 Button Head), 2 x (M6 Washer) and 2 x (M8 Lock Nut) AT THE TOP.

And fasten with 4 x (M6 x 16 Button Head), 4 x (M6 Washer) and 4 x (M8 Lock Nut) ON THE SIDES.

STEP 12

Finish off by installing the Modular Roof Rack onto your vehicle.

Ask your friend to help by lifting the Roof Rack and placing it on the roof, holding it in place and lining up the holes with mounting brackets installed in step 4.

Fasten with 12 x (M8 x 16 Button Heads), 12 x (M8 Washers) and 12 x (M8 Lock Nuts).
