We, Study in Japan Global Network Project, are hosting an online event for the sub-Saharan Africa region: on 3 September 2022, for prospective undergraduate students, and on 30 September - 1 October 2022, for prospective graduate students. Anyone interested in studying at a Japanese university or a graduate school is most welcome to join us (free of charge). 68 programs from 33 Japanese universities are waiting for you.

The first half of the fair is "General Information Session" and the second half, "University Consultation Session". "General Information Session" will include presentations on the overview of studying in Japan, points to consider when applying for scholarships, career paths after graduation, and experiences of current students or alumni from sub-Saharan Africa. "University Consultation Session" will give you an opportunity to meet faculty members and/or administrative staff of each programme of various Japanese universities and ask directly your questions.

Please note that all sessions need to be booked separately once you register for the fair. Japanese universities are eager to have talented African students. We hope this fair will help you apply for Japanese universities with a clear image. In the future, we wish your experience of studying in Japan would contribute to the development of Africa - your "Mother Land".

3. Course details:

The Integrated Science Program is a cross-disciplinary science program for international students interested in pursuing a degree in the sciences at the undergraduate and graduate level. The program's strong cross-disciplinary nature aims to give students an excellent broad scientific education across the core scientific disciplines (physics, chemistry, and biology), while allowing them to specialize in their chosen fields in later years in accordance with their own interests. In addition to the English-based scientific content of the program, a multitude of additional liberal arts courses focusing on business, leadership and management skills, and the Japanese language will be available to ensure students receive a rich and fulfilling education while at Hokkaido University.


Dual Degree Program with the Australian National University at the College of Global Liberal Arts (GLA) : April & September Enrollment

This undergraduate dual degree program is offered jointly by the College of Global Liberal Arts at Ritsumeikan University and the College of Asia & the Pacific (CAP) at the Australian National University. The students study in 3 years in Japan and 1 year in Australia, and will be awarded two degrees in four years, a Bachelor of Global Liberal Arts and a Bachelor of Asia-Pacific Affairs.
