Guest Speaker: Matthew Maynard

Born in Oldham but brought up on Anglesey, Matthew joined Glamorgan CCC making his first-class debut in 1985. A formidable batsman and later in his career wicketkeeper he started his career with a century against Yorkshire at Swansea. Matthew went on to make 754 first team appearances for Glamorgan scoring 35,466 runs, making a club record of 69 centuries. In his time with Glamorgan, they won four trophies including the 1997 County Championship becoming only the third club captain to do so.

England selectors noticed him, and he made his debut in the 5th Test against the West Indies at the Oval in 1988, as many had done that series he fell to Curtly Ambrose and a dominant West Indies side. Following a rebel tour of South Africa led by Mike Gatting, Matthew was not recalled to England duty until hitting a century for Glamorgan against the tourists in 1993, he was called up for the 5th Test against the Australians at Edgbaston.

Following retirement from playing Matthew made a career in coaching and cricket management with two spells at Glamorgan, a period as assistant coach to Duncan Fletcher's England Team that saw an exceptional Ashes victory in 2005 and a time as Director of Cricket at Somerset. Overseas he has coached Titans in South Africa and St Lucia Zouks in the Caribbean. In 2019 Maynard was awarded the MBE for services to sport and charity.
