

Disclaimer dry-cleaning curtains

We would like to point out the following: It is possible that curtains are damaged during the dry-cleaning process due to wear and tear, age, exposure to sunlight, and/or general quality.

Particularly for blackout curtains with a rubber inner layer; this layer may be damaged during dry-cleaning. Cracks or holes may appear or the rubber layer may come off. The risk depends entirely on the age, quality and to what extent the rubber layer has been exposed to sunlight.

Also keep in mind that curtains can shrink (up to a maximum of 5%) due to 'relaxation shrinkage'.

The cause of the relaxation shrinkage lies in the way in which curtains are produced. The fabric is woven under high tension, while a tension-free state is created during the drycleaning of curtains. The fabric then returns to its original shape. The shrinkage that can occur is approximately 3% to 5%. The chance is very small with professional cleaning, but it is present, which is why we would like to point this out to you.
