Manulani Aluli-Meyer is the fifth daughter of Emma Aluli and Harry Meyer who grew up on the sands of Mokapu and Kailua beach on the island of O'ahu. Professor Aluli-Meyer works in the field of indigenous epistemology and its role in world-wide awakening. She obtained her doctorate in Philosophy of Education from Harvard (Ed.D. 1998). Her book: <u>Ho'oulu: Our Time of Becoming</u>, is in its third printing. Her background is in wilderness education, coaching, and experiential learning and she has been an Instructor for Outward Bound, a coach for Special Olympics, and a cheer-leader for the Hawaiian Charter School movement. Dr. Aluli-Meyer has been an Associate Professor of Education at University of Hawai'i at Hilo and spent five years in New Zealand as the lead designer/teacher for He Waka Hiringa, an innovative Masters in Applied Indigenous Knowledge degree at Te Wānanga o Aotearoa, the largest Māori university with 30,000+ students. She is currently the Konohiki for Kūlana o Kapolei (A Hawaiian Place of Learning at University of Hawai'i–West O'ahu).
